During 2022 we have partnered with an industry leading carbon footprint assessor consultant to oversee and support our carbon footprint assessment in line with the industry best practices that were set out in the Greenhouse Gas Protocol (GHG Protocol).

We will voluntarily monitor and develop our reporting to assist with the management of our carbon footprint with consideration for standards such as ISO14064-1 that creates a framework for GHG accounting, verification and quantifying our GHG emissions.

We have initially assessed our CO2e from 1st October 2021 to 1st October 2022 and data captured is contained in this report while an ongoing carbon reduction plan is being developed.

Having reviewed our carbon emissions for the previous 12 months, along with our accredited partner Johnson Allan, we assessed our carbon emissions for this period to be 95 tCO2.

Recommendations to reduce tCO2e

As part of our carbon footprint emissions reduction strategy we will be evaluating the following areas and recommending methods, across the business, to provide a reduction.

Travel	Firstly, consideration should be made as to whether the journey is essential and secondly, can we switch to an alternative method of travel ie public transport.	
Energy - Lighting	Implement energy saving light fittings and room motion sensors.	
Energy - Gas	Review a standard room working temperature and adjust radiators or room thermostats to suits. Also, review hot water temperatures.	
Vehicles	Our aim is to convert our current mixed fleet of vehicles to hybrid and all electrics over the next 3 years as required.	
Packaging Waste	Reduce the amount of packaging waste by implementing a review team and introducing a take back scheme for recycling.
